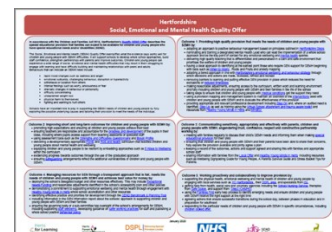


SEND suggested online learning resources:

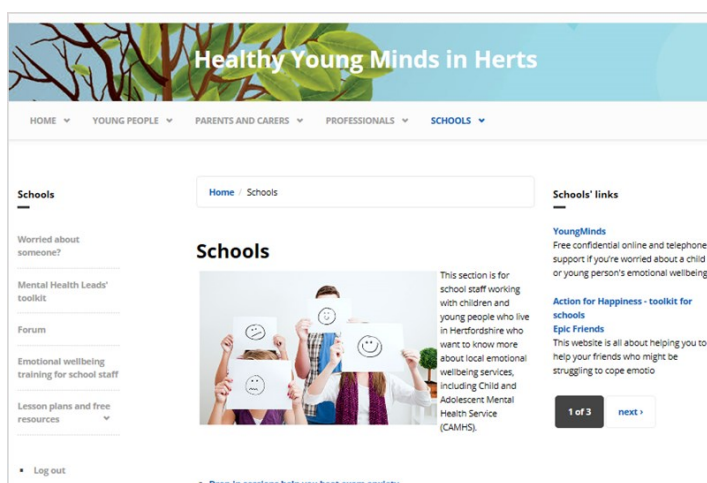


2. On the other hand, now might be the time to explore the SEND toolkit in more detail and share with your staff. Click here to find them on the Local Offer.

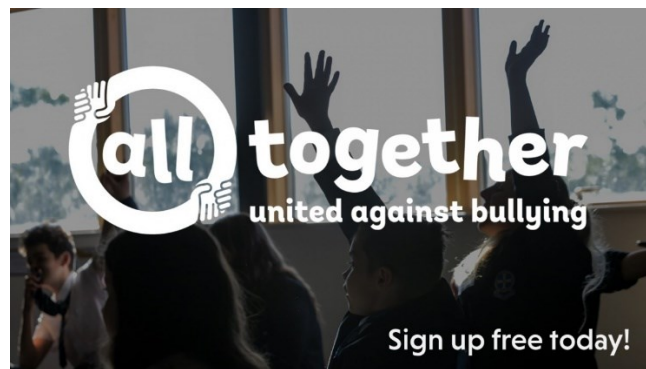
3. Registration to Healthy Young Minds in Herts open to all as long as registering using a schools web address.

5. Anti-bullying alliance, ‘all together programme’ has developed a suite of free online training for anyone that works with children and young people. The programme was developed to reduce levels of bullying of children with SEND. Great for reminding staff about the additional vulnerabilities of children with SEND and covering safeguarding issues.



6. It might be worth having a look through the Inclusion Development Programme (IDP), first published in Removing Barriers to Achievement. The suite of materials aimed to support teachers and teaching assistants to increase their knowledge and skills in working with children & young people with a range of SEND and are useful for early years, primary and secondary phases. You may need to ‘cherry pick’ certain sections as they were published before the revised code of practice but many of the clips and activities are still great.
